




What Is a Continent?

A continent is a very large piece of land (landmass).

There are seven continents in the world:

1. Asia
2. Africa
3. North America
4. South America
5. Antarctica
6. Europe
7. Oceania



Did You Know?

Continents only cover 29% of the Earth. The rest of the Earth's surface is water!

What Is an Ocean?

An ocean is a very large area of salt water. Most of the Earth is covered in ocean.

There are five oceans in the world:

- Pacific Ocean
- Atlantic Ocean
- Indian Ocean
- Southern Ocean
- Arctic Ocean

The map on the right shows the UK. We live in the UK. The official name of the UK is 'The United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland'.

Great Britain is the larger island that contains Scotland, England and Wales.

The UK is part of the **continent** Europe.

Which Countries Make up the UK?


The UK is made up of **four** countries.

The UK – The Union Jack

The official flag for the UK is the Union Flag, sometimes called the Union Jack. It was designed to include the English, Scottish, Welsh and Northern Irish flags.






Each country has its own flag.





Northern Ireland

A thistle is the Scottish national flower.




Wales National Flower

A daffodil is the Welsh national flower.




Northern Ireland National Flower
