

## Our Behaviour Reward System

Here at Childwall CE Primary School we operate a daily behaviour system. As a class the children are involved in creating a set of class promises which help to develop and encourage the Christian Values of our School, that of compassion, friendship, thankfulness and forgiveness.

In the classroom your child will have their picture placed on the sunshine picture. They will remain on the sunshine unless they do not follow the classroom promises.



If this happens they will be given a warning. If their behaviour still does not improve they will be asked to move their photograph onto the thinking cloud and they will be asked to sit out of the activity that they are doing for 5 minutes as a chance to reflect on how they could get back to the sunshine.



Subsequent good behaviour is then rewarded by them moving back to the sunshine.

Further inappropriate behaviour, however, will result in them moving their photograph onto the stormy cloud and then Mrs. Woolnough, Mrs. Duckworth or Mrs. Mason will be informed. Alternatively, time in another class may follow to allow your child to reflect further on their actions and you will be notified at the end of the day. Again, every opportunity will then be given to allow your child to get back to the sunshine.



The important point to remember is that here at Childwall we believe that everyday is a new day so even if your child has been on the stormy cloud they will begin with a fresh start on the sunshine the next day.

If your child has been on the sunshine for a full half term they will receive a sticker and a certificate to reward their consistently positive behaviour at school.
