Meetings: The committee will meet at least three times a year. Minutes of the committee's meetings will be shared with the Full Governing Body and made available to the public upon request. In the absence of the Chair, a temporary Chair will be appointed at the meeting as necessary.

Policies and compliance: The committee will review and ratify the following policies:

- Behaviour for Learning Policy – 2 yearly in the Spring Term
- Bereavement Policy – 2 yearly in the Autumn Term
- British Values Policy – 2 yearly in the Spring Term
- Collective Worship Policy – 2 yearly in the Summer Term

Monitoring: The committee will be responsible for monitoring and evaluating the impact of the school's distinctive Christian character and values on:

- The headteacher's vision in action for the school as a church school.
- Pupils' achievement, attendance, well-being and personal development.
- The effectiveness of opportunities for spiritual, moral, social and cultural (SMSC) development across the curriculum and in the wider life of the school.
- To consider curricular issues; how well the Christian character contributes to academic achievement and personal development of all learners.
- Preparation for Statutory Inspection of Anglican and Methodist Schools (SIAMS).
