A reflection from... Mrs Woolnough

This week we've been thinking about perseverance – keeping going even when things feel tricky. Where have we seen perseverance around school this week?

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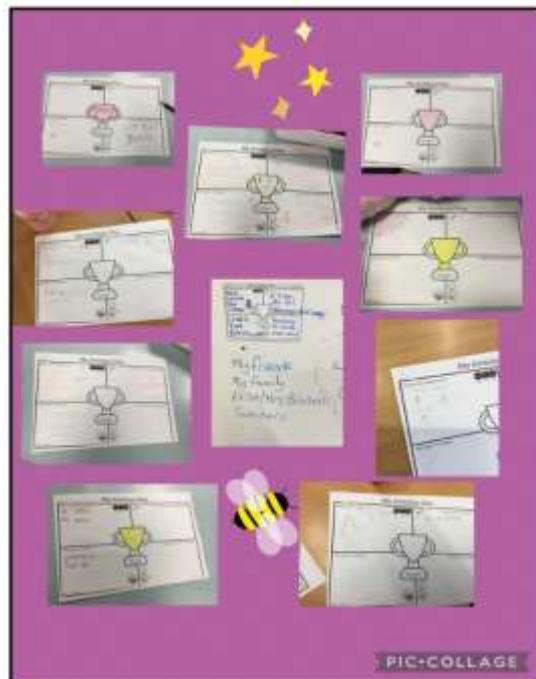
ELSA Support
