



A reflection from ... Mrs Carew

As we continue to focus on the value of perseverance, it's been wonderful to see how children are starting to recognise it in stories and in their own learning. In Year 2, one child pointed out that the boy in *How to Catch a Star* only managed to reach his dream because he kept on trying, even when things didn't work out at first. He didn't give up, and eventually he found his very own star! Moments like this show how children are learning that trying again and again is what helps us succeed – whether it's tackling a tricky maths problem, improving handwriting, or growing more confident with reading. It's wonderful to see them making these connections and realising how important perseverance is.

As the Bible reminds us, **"I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me"** (Philippians 4:13).

So with this knowledge, we can all reach for that star - just like the little boy in the story.


