CURRICULUM OVERVIEWS AND HOMEWORK GRIDS FOR AUTUMN 2

This week we have sent out all the Autumn 2 Curriculum Overviews, so you can see at a glance what your child will be studying this term. We have also shared the Autumn 2 Homework Grids. LOCAL HISTORY AND WORLD WAR WEEK

This week, children across the school have been delving deep into both our local history and key moments from World War II. Each year group has explored fascinating and often challenging topics, encouraging thoughtful discussion and reflection.

- Year 1 have been learning about Lord Derby and his family, discovering their influence on our local area.
- Year 2 have explored the experiences of evacuees during World War II and imagined what life might have been like for children at that time.
- Year 3 have investigated the impact of the Industrial Revolution on our region and how it shaped modern life.
- Year 4 have studied the Windrush Generation and discussed the important contributions they made to post-war Britain.
- Year 5 have examined Liverpool's role in the Transatlantic Slave Trade, even debating whether streets named after slave traders, such as Seel and Parr Street, should be renamed — leading to some powerful and mature discussions.
- Year 6 have undertaken sensitive and thought-provoking work exploring the Holocaust, reflecting deeply on the importance of remembrance and compassion.

It has been a week filled with curiosity, empathy and deep thinking. Please take a moment to talk to your child about what they have learned and which parts of the week they have most enjoyed.

Year 2 Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables.

Year 3 Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 3, 4 and 8 multiplication tables.

Year 4 Recall multiplication and division facts for all multiplication tables up to 12 x 12.

Year 5 & 6 Revision of all times tables and division facts up to 12 x 12.
