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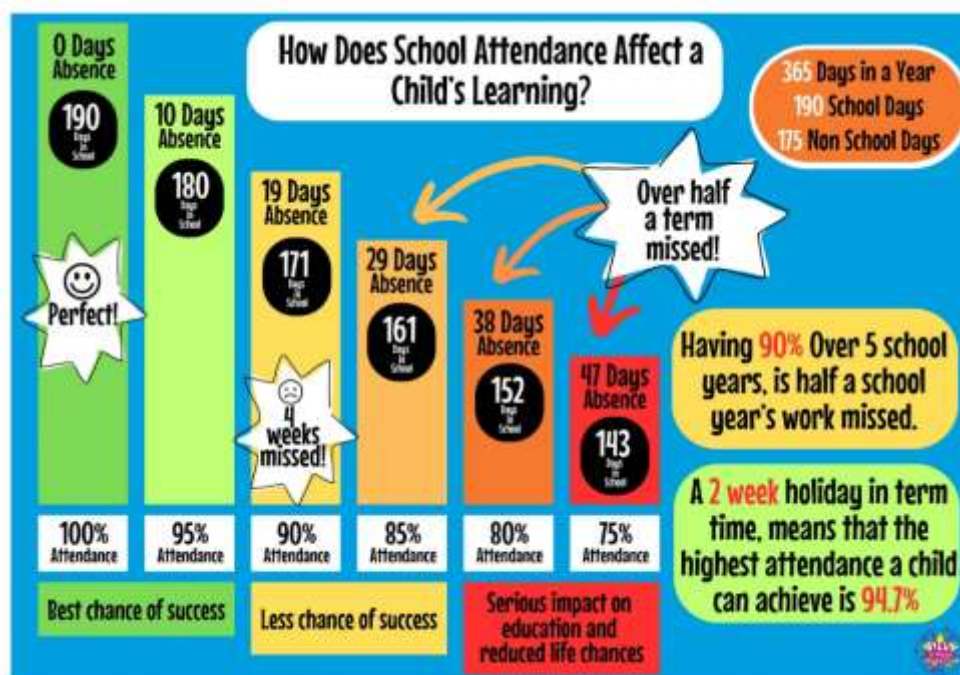
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Our attendance

A reflection of Compassion from Ms Malone

Compassion: Living Out Our Faith as a teacher, a parent, and a person of faith, compassion is a value that guides me every day. As a Year 6 teacher, I am reminded that every child brings their own experiences, worries, and strengths.

Compassion means looking beyond behaviour or academic achievement and ensuring that every child feels valued, supported, and loved as a child of God. National Autistic Society Teenlife Course

The ASD Training Team would like to offer you the opportunity to attend a National Autistic Society course, called Teenlife (your child must have an ASD diagnosis to attend). The course will allow you to build your knowledge on autism and meet / share information with other parents/carers.

Teenlife is a six-session programme for parents/carers of young people, aged 10 to 16 years, with autism. The aim of Teenlife is to share information, experiences and ideas in a structured way. Teenlife emphasises the importance of autistic perspectives, with a variety of videos and quotes used throughout the sessions.

Topics covered include:

- understanding autism in teenagers;
- self-esteem and spending time with other people;
- stress and anxiety;
- understanding your diagnosis;
- puberty and independence;
- education and planning for the future.
