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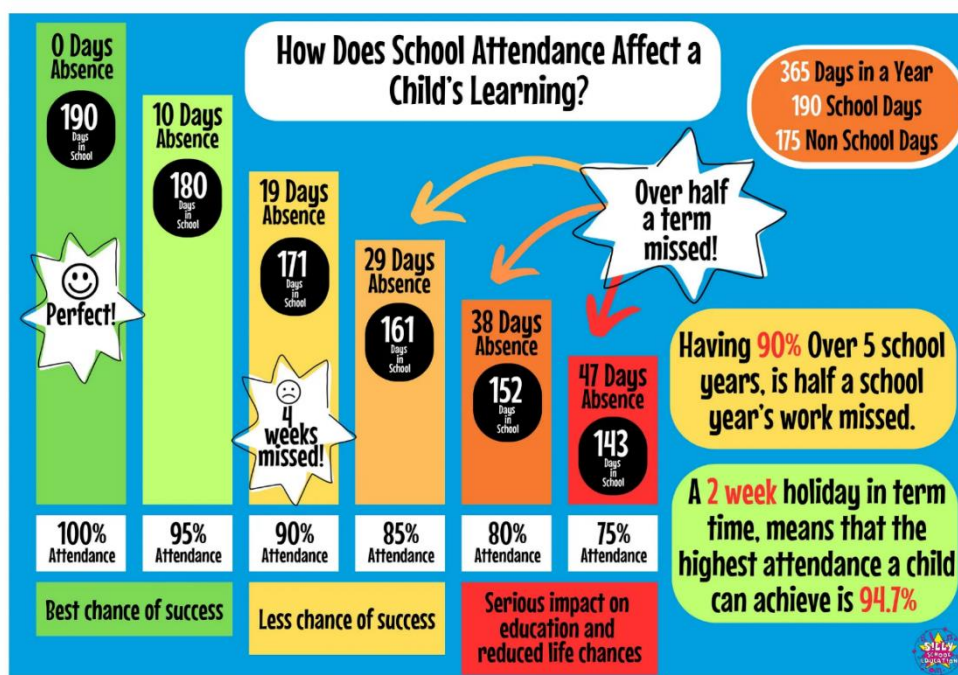
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Our attendance

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A reflection of Compassion from Mrs Duckworth

As we move through the summer term, school life is full of activity. There are trips, sporting events, performances, assessments, celebrations and many opportunities for learning both inside and outside the classroom. It is a wonderful and vibrant time of year, but it can also be a time when we all feel particularly busy.

In the midst of so much activity, it is worth reflecting on the importance of compassion.

Compassion is at the heart of our Christian vision. Jesus showed compassion to everyone He met, taking time to notice those who needed encouragement, support or simply a listening ear. His example reminds us that kindness is not something we show only when life is calm and easy; it is something we are called to demonstrate every day.

Often, it is during our busiest times that compassion matters most. When we are rushing from one task to another, it can be easy to become focused on our own responsibilities. Yet a kind word, a patient response, or a thoughtful gesture can make a significant difference to someone else's day.

As a school community, we see compassion in action every day: pupils helping one another with their learning, friends including others in games and conversations, staff supporting colleagues, and families working together to help children flourish. These moments, though sometimes small, reflect the love and care that underpin our community.

The Bible reminds us to "be kind and compassionate to one another" (Ephesians 4:32). This simple instruction encourages us to pause, notice the needs of others, and respond with generosity and understanding.

As we continue through this busy and exciting term, may we all seek opportunities to show compassion in our words and actions. In doing so, we help to build a community where everyone feels valued, supported and loved.

Jacob did amazingly well, especially considering the hot weather on the day. To make things even more challenging, he took a wrong turn and ended up cycling **15.5 miles** – but he

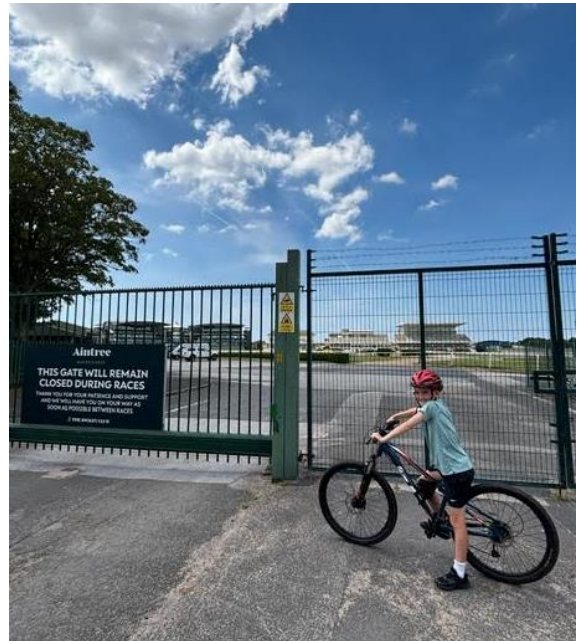

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National Autistic Society Teenlife Course

The ASD Training Team would like to offer you the opportunity to attend a National Autistic Society course, called Teenlife (your child must have an ASD diagnosis to attend). The course will allow you to build your knowledge on autism and meet / share information with other parents/carers.

Teenlife is a six-session programme for parents/carers of young people, aged 10 to 16 years, with autism. The aim of Teenlife is to share information, experiences and ideas in a structured way. Teenlife emphasises the importance of autistic perspectives, with a variety of videos and quotes used throughout the sessions.

Topics covered include:

- understanding autism in teenagers;
- self-esteem and spending time with other people;
- stress and anxiety;
- understanding your diagnosis;
- puberty and independence;
- education and planning for the future.
