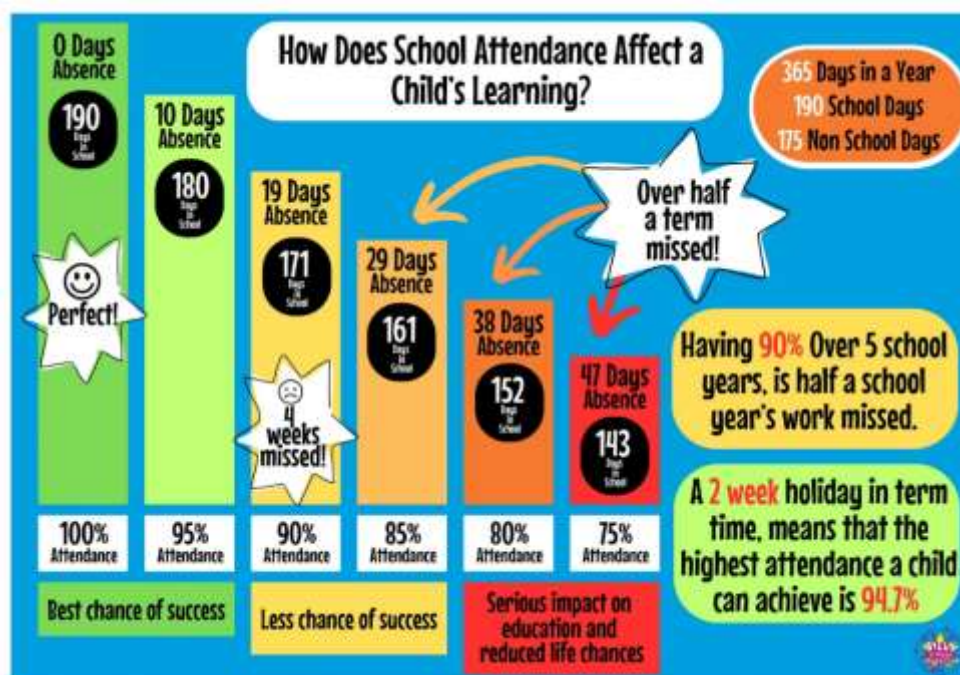

## NEW PE UNIFORM

We are pleased to introduce our new PE top, which is now available from Kitted Out.

The new top is made from a more breathable fabric, providing greater comfort for pupils during PE lessons and classroom learning. It has also been designed to match our current school PE tracksuit, creating a consistent look across the PE uniform.

The new PE top will go live today and can be purchased directly from Kitted Out. While it is available to purchase from today, it will become part of the

school PE uniform from September, ready for the start of the new academic year.

To help when ordering, here are the recommend sizes:

- \* 22–24 – typically suitable for Reception and some Year 1 pupils.
- \* 26–28 – typically suitable for pupils in Years 2, 3 and 4.
- \* 30–32 – typically suitable for pupils in Years 5 and 6.
- \* 32–34 – recommended for taller children.

Here is a reminder of our lunchtime options:

1. Packed Lunch for Junior Children
2. Packed Lunch with Fishy Friday for Junior Children
3. School Dinner

Once you have selected an option, this will need to remain the option for the remainder of the half term. This ensures that our kitchen staff are able to order and prepare the correct number of school meals. The cost of a school dinner is £2.40 per day and must be paid for weekly in advance. All infant children receive a Universal Free School Meal.
