## Autumn One in Year 5

### English

We are looking at diary entries, narrative retelling and persuasive speech.

We will be focusing on:

- Devices to build cohesion within a paragraph
- Linking ideas across paragraphs using adverbials of time, place, number and tense choices
- Relative clauses beginning with who, which, where, when, whose, that, or an omitted relative pronoun

We are reading...



### Maths

We will be looking at:

- Reasoning with large whole integers
- Integer addition and subtraction
- Line graphs and timetables
- Multiplication and division
- Perimeter and area

We will also be focusing on developing arithmetic skills and strengthening multiplication and division facts.

We will be developing our reading skills in daily 'Are You Really Reading?' sessions.

Children will also be receiving a home reading book. This will be read at home and in school once a week.

### Science

We are Planetary Physicists

We will be learning about Earth and Space.

We will learn about:

- The movement of the Earth and Sun
- Day and night
- The phases of the moon
- The other planets in our solar system relative to the sun



### RE

We will be learning all about the Bible.

The key questions we will be focusing on are:

- Why is the Bible a bestseller?
- Why are there so many versions of the Bible?
- Why are sacred texts so important to people of faith?
- In what ways do the contents of sacred texts impact on believers?

### History

We will be learning all about the Romans

We will be looking at the following key questions

- What impact did Romans have on Britain?
- Was the Roman Empire a force for good?

Children will learn about

- Romulus and Remus and their significance to the origins of Ancient Rome
- The Roman Republic and compare it to modern day British politics
- Know who Julius Caesar was and why his life was significant
- Julius Caesar's death
- Caesar Augustus and his significance
- Emperor Claudius and his significance
- Queen Boudicca and her significance
- The impact the Romans had on local history



### PE

Our units will be:

- Dodgeball
- Handball/Swimming

Our PE days are: Tuesday and Friday for both 5D and 5P.

Swimming for 5P will be on a Thursday in the autumn term. 5D will be swimming in the spring term.

### Art

Children will

- Understand that designers create fonts and work with typography
- Understand that some artists use graphic skills to create pictorial maps using symbols (personal and cultural) to map identity as well as geography
- Children will create fonts inspired by objects/elements around them
- Children will draw over maps/existing marks to explore how they can make mark making more visually powerful
- Children will combine drawing with making to create pictorial/3 dimension maps

### Homework

- Children will have weekly spellings to learn
- Children will have access to Times Tables Rock Stars
- Children are encouraged to read 5 times a week
- Children to complete one homework task from the homework grid every two weeks
