Creative Thinkers	Create a poster about two different animals. Can you label them showing how they are different? The five classes of vertebrates (animals with backbones) are... Mammals, Reptiles, Fish, Amphibians, Birds	Create a map (using IT or by hand) of the UK and all of the different places you have visited. Maybe you have family members or friends from different parts of the UK?	Draw or make a basket (using paper weaving) and fill it with fruit/vegetable cutouts or stickers. Write a prayer thanking God for these precious gifts.
Independent Enquirers	Research and write a fact file on any animal of your choice. Think about what it looks like, what it can do or can't do and where it lives.	Investigate some of the key landmarks and capital cities of the countries of the UK. Can you think of some of the differences between them?	Research how Jewish people celebrate Harvest. It has a special name beginning with S!
Reflective Learners	Write a diary about a day (it doesn't have to be true!) where you used all 5 senses. What did you see, hear, smell, touch and taste?	Pretend you're visiting Scotland, Wales, England, or Northern Ireland. Draw a picture (e.g., Loch Ness monster, a castle, a red bus, or Giant's Causeway) and write one sentence about what you "saw."	Write a prayer thanking God for the precious gift of food.
Team Worker	Work as a team to create a shoebox habitat – research an animal's habitat and try to create it with art materials inside a shoebox.	With a grownup, look in your kitchen or supermarket for foods that come from the UK (like apples, milk, cheese, bread, potatoes). Draw 3–4 of them on a "UK Food Plate."	With a grown-up or a friend, cut a tree shape from paper. Add leaf cutouts where you write or draw things you are thankful for (food, family, friends, sunshine).
