Geography



We will be studying the UK, identifying capital cities and landmarks of each of the countries, human and physical features, the surrounding seas, cities' characteristics and the difference between these and towns, and identifying features of the local area using observational skills and aerial photographs.

Science

We are learning about animals, including humans. We will be... identifying and naming a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, identifying and naming a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores, describing and comparing the structure of a variety of common animals (fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals, including pets), identifying, naming, drawing and labelling the basic parts of the human body and saying which part of the body is associated with each sense.
